FUND MANAGER COMMENTS

The Fund generated a positive return, outperforming its benchmark. August saw major government bond yields drift higher, while credit spreads initially followed equities in rallying tighter, but then drifted sideways for the second part of the month. The main positive was the positioning in corporate credit, wherein although we were only very modestly long risk, our strong security and sector selection meant we delivered decent outperformance, notably from our picks in financials. Elsewhere, yield curve, emerging market debt and currency positioning were all modest negatives for the month. Our modest long positions in loans and asset-backed securities also added performance as spreads continued to grind tighter in those asset classes. Inflation positioning was a modest positive contributor as we sold our last holdings of US Treasury inflation-protected securities.



DURATION EXPOSURE BY MATURITY


