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

The US long duration fixed income composite, which was formerly known as the Long duration strategy composite prior to 1/1/15, has been examined for the periods January 1, 2013–December 31, 2016. The examination report is available upon request. The investment objective of our US long duration fixed income strategy is to maximize risk-adjusted total return with a combination of income and capital appreciation. The portfolio seeks to achieve its objective by primarily investing in a diversified portfolio of investment-grade fixed income securities while managing duration within +/- 20% of its benchmark, the Barclays US Long Government /Credit index. The Barclays US Long Government/Credit index measures the investment return of all medium and larger public issues of US Treasury, agency, investment-grade corporate, and investment-grade international dollar-denominated bonds with maturities longer than 10 years. The average maturity is approximately 20 years. Composite guidelines allow for out of benchmark allocations. Portfolio strategy will focus on active portfolio management with emphasis on sector allocation and security selection. This composite was created August 31, 2010. The inception date for this composite is September 1, 2010. The management fee schedule for this composite is as follows: 0.30% on the first \$25 million, 0.25% on the next \$25 million and 0.20% thereafter. All fees are subject to negotiation and are dependent on account services provided and size of portfolio. Actual investment advisory fees incurred by clients may vary. Prior to 1/1/2011, net of fee performance returns were calculated by deducting the highest management fee paid by any account in the composite from the monthly gross composite return. Effective 1/1/2011, composite returns. Client returns will be reduced by investment management fees. Actual fees for new accounts are dependent upon size and any fee or fee schedule applied to existing or prospective clients is subject to negotiation.



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
