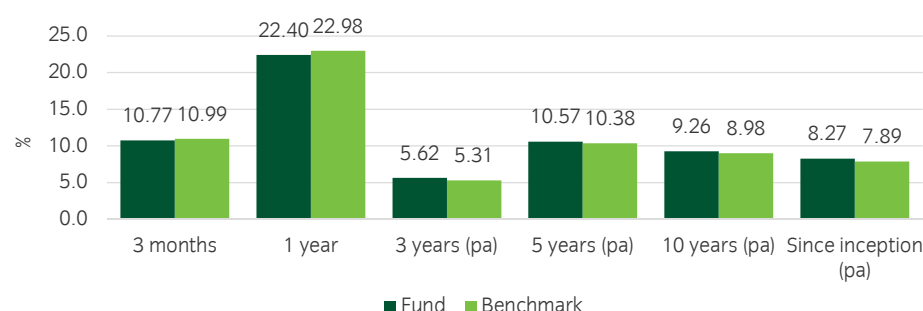
FUND OBJECTIVE

FUND MANAGER COMMENTS

The Fund delivered a positive return but underperformed its benchmark. Yield curve positioning contributed negatively. We held a position in the UK favouring 30-year gilts over 50-year maturities on valuation grounds, but this detracted from returns as the quarter progressed and the yield curve flattened. Inflation positioning also detracted from performance. We continued to hold a long position in US 30-year inflation breakevens. In August, renewed risk aversion led inflation expectations to fall globally to levels not seen since the 2016 energy crisis. Duration positioning made a positive contribution to returns. We actively traded duration on the short side, with a slight emphasis on Europe.

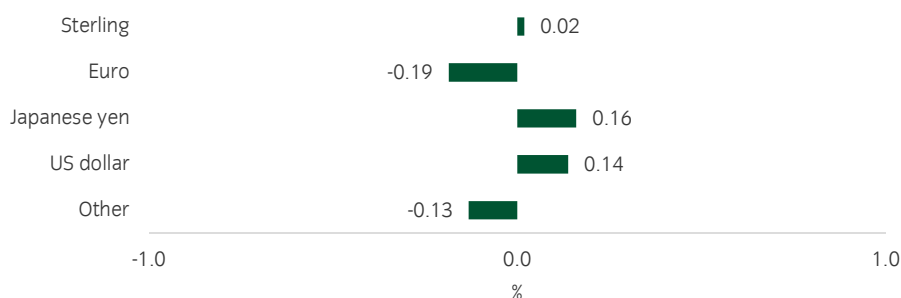
