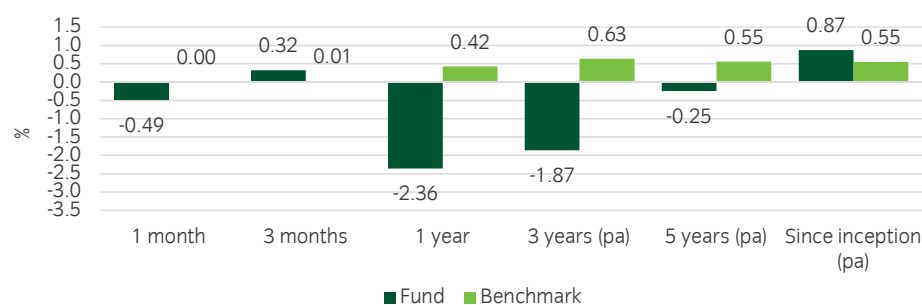
FUND OBJECTIVE

FUND MANAGER COMMENTS

The Fund generated a negative return, underperforming its benchmark. The main negative contribution was from country selection, chiefly due to our long US vs Germany position which we added during the month. This position has since recovered somewhat in November to date and we continue to believe there is more upside to be gained. Our long duration position in the US also suffered as US yields rose. Our yield curve 'flattener' trades in Italy and Germany were also hit by curve steepening in Europe. We continue to hold these positions. In credit, the main positive was our positioning in corporate credit, wherein we continued to be modestly long risk. Our short credit default swap (CDS) position held against an offsetting long position in physical cash bonds (a "basis" trade) position also benefitted strongly as CDS continued to underperform cash on a risk-adjusted basis. Asset-backed securities were a small negative while loans were positive. Emerging market debt was neutral while currency was a modest positive.

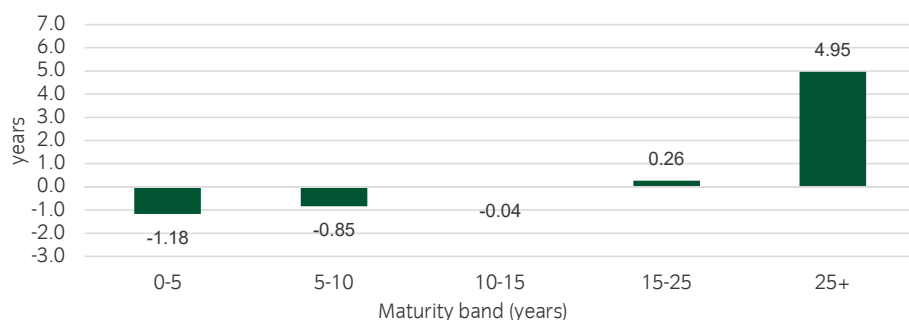

DURATION EXPOSURE BY MATURITY

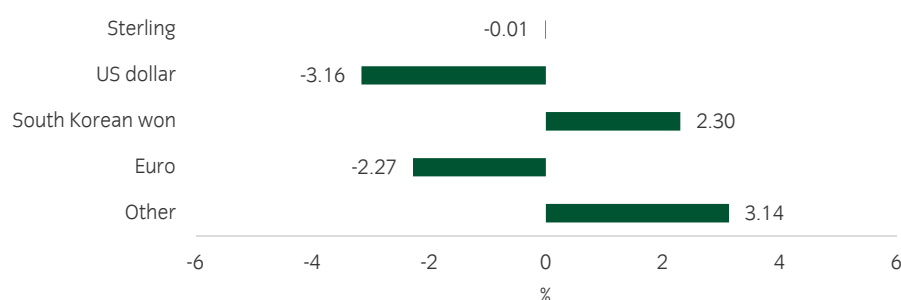
