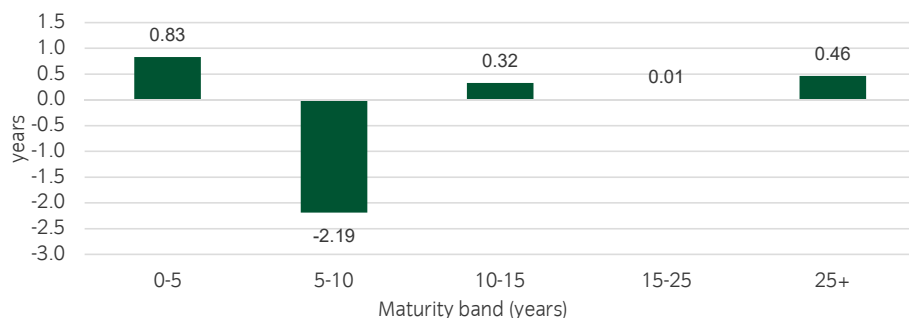
FUND MANAGER COMMENTS

The Fund generated a negative return over the month, underperforming its benchmark. Global government bond markets continued to rally strongly as increasing COVID-19 cases around the world resulted in more mobility restrictions. Credit spreads widened slightly. In emerging markets, our long FX positions markedly detracted from performance (most notably in Chile, Colombia, Hungary and Korea). Due to long positions in commodity currencies and emerging markets, our currency positions also detracted modestly. Our interest rate strategies, in aggregate, slightly detracted. Duration positioning was a small negative due to having a tactical short position in Bunds and a strategic short position in Gilts as yields fell. Yield curve positioning also marginally detracted. Country selection was neutral. However, our credit strategies, in aggregate, positively contributed. The long positions in asset-backed securities and loans made small profits and there were also gains in corporates.

DURATION EXPOSURE BY MATURITY

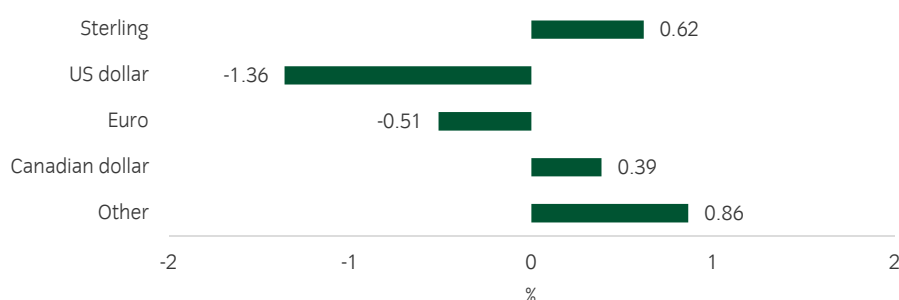
