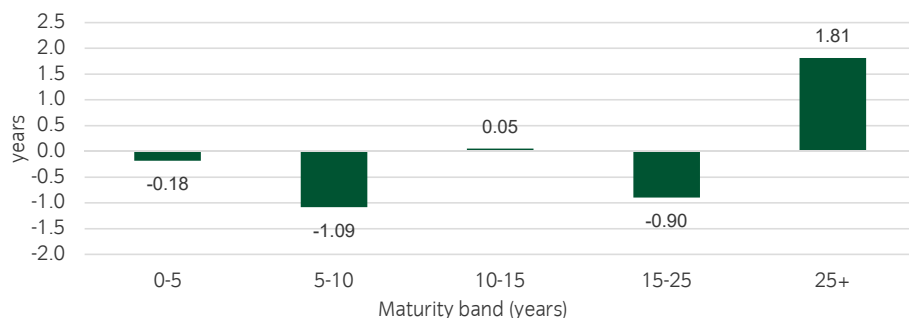
FUND MANAGER COMMENTS

The Fund generated a positive return over the month, outperforming its benchmark. The sell-off in global government bonds accelerated given higher-than-expected inflation and increasingly hawkish central banks. Credit spreads widened. Interest rate positioning was positive. Duration positioning was the main positive due to having short positions in Gilts and US Treasuries as yields moved higher. Our long positions in China also positively contributed. Country selection was supportive, with the main drivers being our long position in 10-year Australian government bonds and a short position in 10-year Canadian government bonds versus US Treasuries. However, the Fund's yield curve positioning was detrimental given our steepening positions in Germany and the UK. Credit positioning was positive. Our corporate credit allocation was a positive while asset-backed securities and loans generated income. Lastly, our long emerging markets positions and foreign currency overlay slightly detracted.

DURATION EXPOSURE BY MATURITY

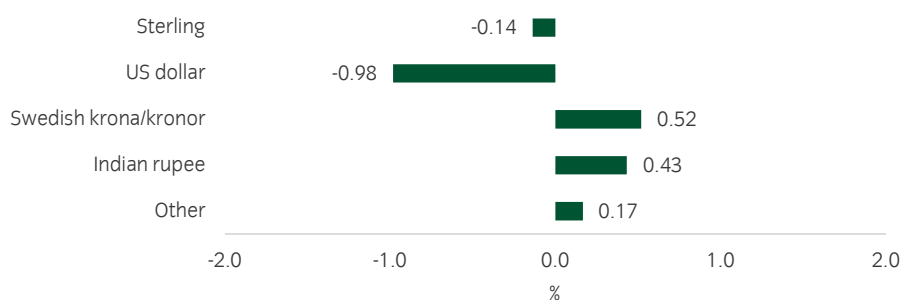
