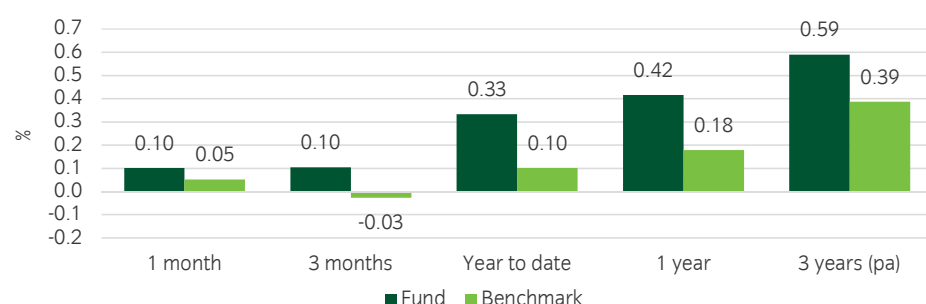
FUND OBJECTIVE

FUND MANAGER COMMENTS

In October, the Bank of England (BoE) began a "fact-finding mission" to see how negative rates could impact banks. However, the bank's governor, Andrew Bailey, suggested the strategy will not be employed for now. Meanwhile, a surge in COVID-19 cases prompted more severe lockdown restrictions throughout the UK. In response, the BoE is expected to announce a £100 billion increase to its asset-purchase programme during November's Monetary Policy Committee meeting. In markets, 1-month sterling LIBOR fell from 0.05% to 0.04% over October, while the 3-month rate decreased from 0.06% to 0.05%. In gilt markets, 2-year gilt yields were flat at -0.03%, while 5-year gilt yields fell from -0.06% to -0.04%. With interest rates set to remain at ultra-low levels for the foreseeable future (unless inflation notably picks up), fund activity was limited to very short-dated assets. The weighted average maturity of the Fund was 39 days at the end of September and 37 days at the end of October.

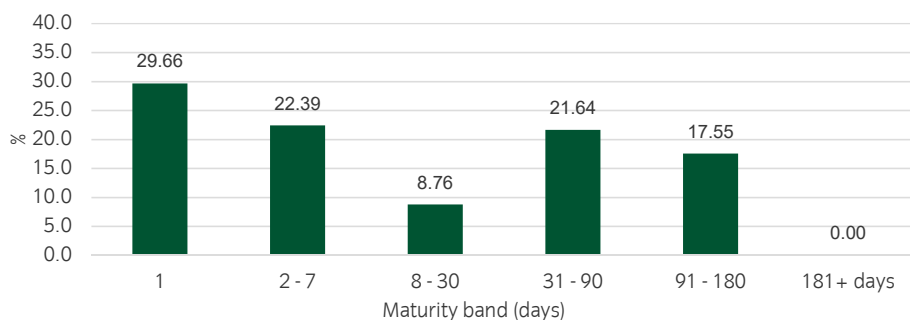

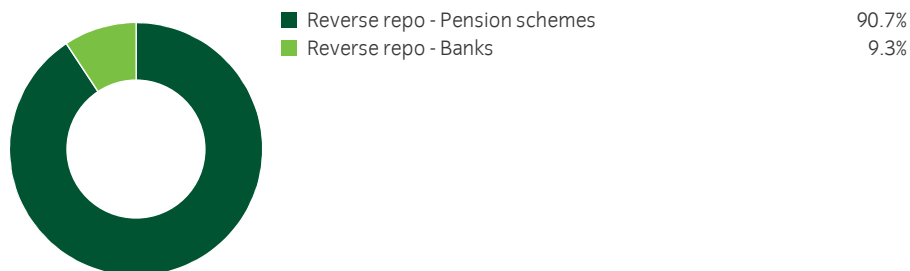
