FUND MANAGER COMMENTS

The annual rate of inflation was unchanged at 2.2% in April. According to a second estimate, the eurozone economy's growth rate was downgraded by 10bp to 0.3% during the first quarter. The Manufacturing Purchasing Managers' Index rose from 49.0 in April to 49.4 in May. According to a preliminary estimate, the Services Purchasing Managers' Index declined from 50.1 to 48.9. The unemployment rate remained at 6.2% in March. In markets, 1-month EURIBOR fell from 2.17% to 1.97%, while the 3-month rate declined from 2.16% to 1.99%. We bought certificates of deposit from UBS. We bought floating-rate notes from the Royal Bank of Canada. We both bought and sold floating-rate notes from NatWest Bank. Positioning will be determined by central bank meetings.

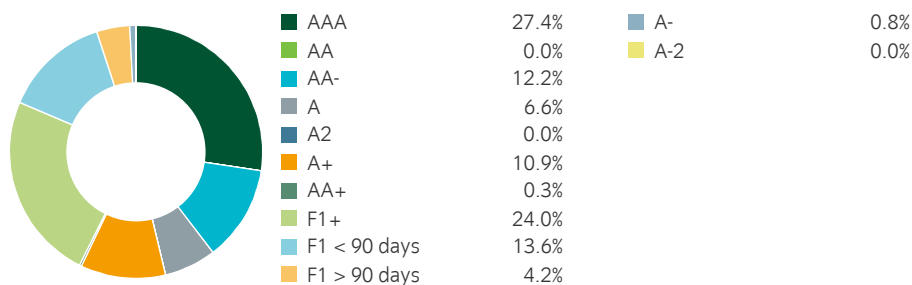

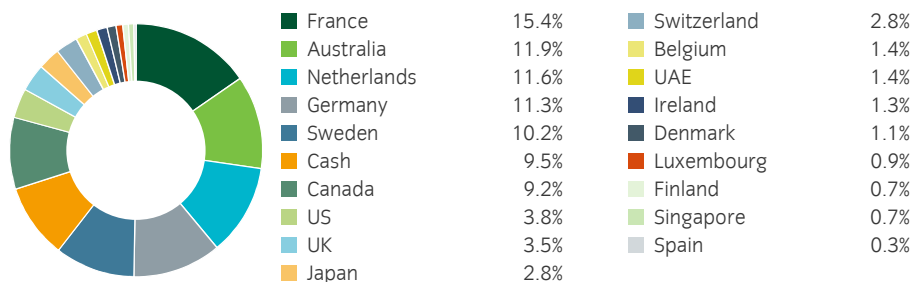

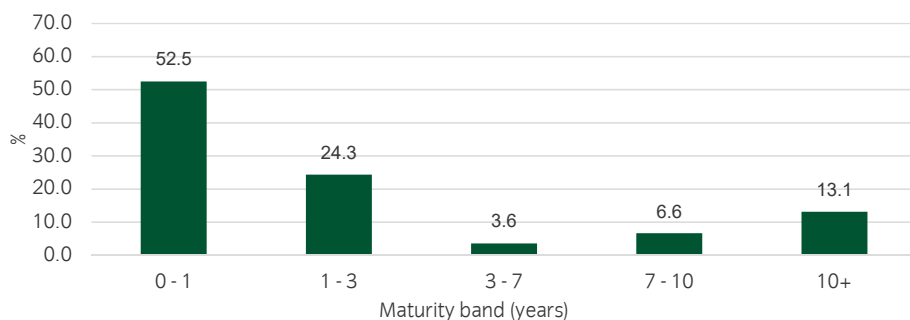

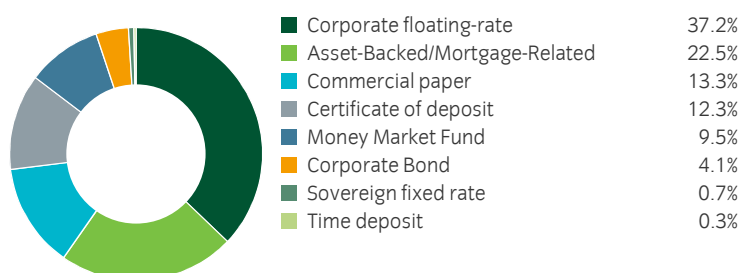
