FUND MANAGER COMMENTS

Annual inflation in the UK fell from 6.8% in July to 6.7% in August, due to slowing food price rises. The Bank of England maintained interest rates at 5.25% at its September meeting. Second quarter economic growth was confirmed at 0.2%. The manufacturing purchasing managers' index rose from 43 in August to 44.3 in September. In markets, SONIA remained unchanged at 5.18%, while the 2-year gilt yield declined from 5.14% to 4.89% and the 5-year gilt yield decreased from 4.66% to 4.50%. We added certificates of deposit and commercial paper from UBS, Nordea, La Banque Postale, First Abu Dhabi Bank, CBA, Santander, OP Corporate Bank, Credit Agricole and Bank of America. We also bought UK Treasury bills and floating rate notes from the Royal Bank of Canada. We will continue to position for further central bank rate hikes, with risks around the stickiness of inflation. The weighted average maturity of the Fund was 37 days at the end of August and 40 days at the end of September.






